Adults are off-white or gray and raise the head when resting to give body a sloping appearance

These moths particularly favor flour dust but will infest other grain and foodstuffs. The larvae produce extensive and a characteristic loose webbing. The adults do not feed and they are short-lived.

Mediterranean Flour Moths are noted for their extensive webbing that can clog production machinery. The larva begin spinning the silken webbing soon after they hatch out of eggs.
