

Using Baits and Pheromones for cockroach control

Several bait materials are available to control cockroaches in both residential and commercial situations. Advantages include lack of odor and low toxicity. As with any pesticide each situation requires a custom evaluation and a professional application by trained professionals. Some materials are gels or pastes that are injected into cracks and crevices. Some materials require use of a bait station. Your PARATEX professional will help determine the proper material and application schedule.

Injecting Avert gel into cracks

Knowing where to place baits is critical. Avert may need up to 24 bait points per 100 sq ft and require 5 to 7 days to be effective. Placing material in cracks is a way to reduce exposure to people and pets.



Roach Bait Station



Pheromone traps make use of a sex attractant to lure roaches into the container where they are usually stuck in a sticky material. They don't usually provide control, but are useful in monitoring infestations and they are helpful where insecticides can't be used.
